

Pathways to Healing Fund

Recognizing that communities know best how to honour Survivors and Remember the Children Who Never Made it Home, Southern Chiefs' Organization is providing grants to our member First Nations that want to host community events, gatherings, and ceremonies to honour the strength and resiliency of the Survivors of the Residential and Day Schools, 60s Scoop and Child Welfare System, the families of MMIWG2S+, and to Remember the Children.

1. One grant per First Nation will be distributed. Grant applications must include a letter of support from your Chief and Council.
2. Communities will be eligible for funding up to a maximum of \$20,000 and funds must be spent within the 2023-2024 fiscal year.
3. Cheques will be sent in care of the First Nation, or to a community host organization with the approval of Chief and Council.
4. Please apply for funding a minimum of three weeks before your event.
